### August 3, Home – Boston

Depart by motorcoach to a Boston Logan Airport hotel for an overnight stay *Meals: Dinner* 

# August 4, Boston - Fairbanks

Depart on a morning flight to Fairbanks. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. Excitement is in the air as you anticipate your Alaska adventure!

August 5, Fairbanks

Start your day with a complimentary breakfast before embarking on a deluxe motorcoach tour of Fairbanks, also known as "The Golden Heart City." At the Morris Thompson Cultural and Visitor Center, gain insight into the history and culture of Interior and Arctic Alaska. Then, you'll visit the Trans-Atlantic Pipeline stretching 800 miles from Prudhoe Bay to Valdez. After lunch on your own, climb aboard a sternwheeler for a scenic three-hour cruise down the Chena River, where you'll meet a local family who have made their living from Alaska's rivers for five generations. Witness an Alaskan bush pilot take off right next to the boat, and sail past the home and kennel of the late four-time Iditarod champion, Susan Butcher. Finally, enjoy a delicious Alaska salmon bake dinner to cap off a memorable day.

# August 6, Fairbanks - Denali

Embark on a morning journey aboard the deluxe dome rail to Denali, savoring a delightful breakfast with engaging narration about the landscape and wildlife. After lunch, venture on the Tundra Wilderness Bus Tour in Denali National Park searching for bears, moose, caribou, Dall sheep, and more. # August 7, Denali – Anchorage

Continue to Anchorage, where upon arrival, you'll have a brief orientation of Alaska's largest city. Wrap up the day with a delightful, included dinner.

# August 8, Anchorage - Seward

Begin your day on a scenic journey by motorcoach along the Turnagain Arm to Seward. Immerse yourself in the natural beauty of Potter Marsh with a presentation on its rich history and diverse bird species. Continue exploration with a visit to the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center for an up-close encounter animal presentation. Conclude your adventure in Seward. Where you'll board the CELEBRITY SUMMIT departing at 8:00 PM.

Edging the Kenai Peninsula and framed by the glacier-covered Kenai Mountains that run along its southeastern spine, Seward is a rustic port town whose grand terrain will leave you breathless. Discover the wonder of the Kenai Peninsula from your ship. The pristine wilderness is home to nesting seabirds, countless islands, wetlands, and breathtaking views. *Meals: Breakfast, Box Lunch, Dinner* 

# **August 9, Hubbard Glacier - Cruising**

Greeting you as we enter Yakutat Bay is Hubbard Glacier, one of Alaska's most exciting treasures. Enjoy incredible picture-perfect views of this glorious mount of ice from about every angle on your ship. Named after Gardiner Hubbard, the founder and president of the National Geographic Society, Hubbard Glacier is the longest tidewater glacier in the world. Dramatically massive at about 7-miles wide, 76-miles long and as tall as a 30-story building above the waterline, it's the largest river of ice in North America. Keep your binoculars handy to watch the drama of calving icebergs. An onboard naturalist narrates the experience while keeping an eye out for the whales, harbor seals, and otters that hunt and play in the waters of the bay. *Meals: B, L, D* 

# August 10, Juneau

Here the pioneering spirit lives on in an interesting mix of cosmopolitan chic and frontier ruggedness. Nestled between mountains and sea, and inaccessible by land, Juneau offers much to explore. Visit the Alaska State Museum and its exquisite collection of Russian Orthodox and Gold Rush relics, meander through shops, or visit impressive the Mendenhall Glacier, one of 38 glaciers in the Juneau ice field. *Meals: B, L, D*August 11, Skagway

It's doubtful you'll succumb to gold fever, but if any place on earth can summon up the thrill of prospecting, it's Skagway. By embracing its gold-rush past, Skagway has managed to preserve a frontier spirit complete with saloons and dance- hall revues. If the spirit does overtake you, travel the White Pass & Yukon Railway or ride a ride on the Klondike Highway to places where you can roll up your sleeves and do some prospecting of your own. *Meals: B, L, D* 

# **August 12, Icy Strait Point**

Fifty miles west of Juneau and at the mouth of Glacier Bay lies historic Icy Strait Point. For thousands of years, the Tlingit Indians have called this place home. Here you have the unique opportunity to experience superior wildlife viewing, and years of Alaskan history. *Meals: B, L, D*August 13, Ketchikan

In addition to being the jumping-off point for seaplane excursions into the Misty Fjords National Monument and its 2.2 million acres of wilderness nirvana, Ketchikan is also the ancestral home of the Tlingit tribe. Another "must-see" here is the world's largest collection of totem poles. *Meals: B, L, D* 

# **August 14, Inside Passage - Cruising**

Threading along the scenic coast of Alaska and Canada, the Inside Passage is a complex labyrinth of fjords, bays, and lush green islands, home to an abundance of wildlife, including orca, mountain goats, bald eagles, bears, puffins, sea otters and much more. *Meals: B, L, D*August 15, Vancouver, British Columbia - Boston

Vancouver, Canada's "Gateway to the Pacific", displays both laid-back beauty and cosmopolitan flair. From the harbor entrance, see the "Lions' Gate", the twin mountain peaks that resemble crouching lions. Disembark our cruise ship and transfer to the airport for your flight home. *Meals: B*
