# ITINERARY

## **Thursday October 16, 2025**

On the first day of the America The Beautiful tour, we'll embark on an early morning departure from New Hampshire, heading south toward the vibrant city of Philadelphia. As we journey through picturesque landscapes, there will be opportunities to relax, enjoy light refreshments, and participate in fun on-board activities to set the tone for the adventure ahead. Upon arrival in Philadelphia in the afternoon, we'll check into our hotel, giving everyone a chance to unwind. If you are ready to get out and explore, there are many museums and exciting things to see a short walk from our hotel. The noteworthy Benjamin Franklin Museum is just steps from the hotel. The day will conclude with dinner on your own, followed by a relaxing evening in the city before settling in for the night.

## **Friday October 17, 2025**

This morning, the group will set out on a captivating historical tour, where we'll visit the iconic Liberty Bell, a symbol of American independence, and explore surrounding landmarks at Independence National Historical Park. After the tour, we will head to the famous Reading Terminal Market to explore the numerous food stalls and have lunch on your own.

After departing from Philadelphia, our journey continues toward the nation's capital, Washington, D.C. We'll arrive in the late afternoon, and begin an unforgettable evening in this historic city. The evening will begin with a group dinner at a local D.C. restaurant, where we'll enjoy regional cuisine and have a chance to relax and share experiences from the day. Following dinner, we'll embark on a breathtaking nighttime monument tour, where the illuminated landmarks of Washington, D.C. come to life. From the towering Washington Monument to the stately Lincoln Memorial, and the solemn World War II Memorial, we'll experience these iconic sites in a serene, moonlit atmosphere. This tour will provide a unique perspective on the nation's capital before we retire to our hotel for the night. (Meals: B, D)

## **Saturday October 18, 2025**

The day will begin with a tour of the most recognized symbol of democratic government. The U.S. Capitol has housed Congress since 1800 and is one of the most imposing public buildings in the world. The Capitol is where Congress meets to write the laws of our nation, and where presidents are inaugurated. Its ceilings are decorated with historic images, and its halls are lined with statuary and paintings representing great events and people in the nation's history.

After the tour, you will have time to explore the many museums on offer in DC. A few of the most popular are listed below.

### **Botanic Gardens**

United States Botanic Garden, established by the U.S. Congress in 1820, is one of the oldest botanic gardens in North America. Through the Conservatory, National Garden, and Bartholdi Park, the Garden informs visitors about the importance and fundamental value and diversity of plants, as well as their aesthetic, cultural, economic, therapeutic and ecological significance.

### **Museum of Natural History**

We'll spend the afternoon at the Museum of Natural History exploring the various exhibits they have available.

### **Museum of American History**

Browse through the new state-of-the-art gallery that offers a spectacular view of the Star Spangled Banner, and view the exhibits that top the list of must-sees for any visitor with a taste for true Americana. See the First Ladies' inaugural gowns, quilts, cars, locomotives and much, much more.

### **National Air & Space Museum**

Experience the history of flight at one of the world's most visited museums, from the plane flown by the Wright brothers to the Apollo 11 command module. Features an incredible collection of aviation and space technology treasures.

### **National Archives**

Stop by the National Archives Museum to see the home of the Declaration of Independence, Constitution, and Bill of Rights.

### **Library of Congress**

The Library of Congress is the nation's oldest federal cultural institution, and it serves as the research arm of Congress. If your group would like to visit, we will need to reserve a timed ticket.

### **United States Holocaust Memorial Museum**

Tour the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum. This somber and moving museum tells the story of the Holocaust through artifacts, films, photographs and oral histories. The museum's primary mission is to inform Americans about the Holocaust, to remember those who suffered, and to inspire visitors to contemplate the moral implications of their choices and responsibilities as citizens in an interdependent world.

After exploring the museums to your heart's content, we will make our way to the White House Visitor Center and take a few photos of the outside! The day will end with a dinner cruise on the Potomac River, offering a magical and relaxing way to experience Washington, D.C., from a unique vantage point. As you board the elegant boat, you'll be greeted by the stunning backdrop of the city's skyline, with iconic landmarks such as the Washington Monument, the U.S. Capitol, and the Kennedy Center glowing against the evening sky. Once underway, you'll enjoy a delicious dinner, featuring a selection of local dishes. (Meals: B,D)

### **Sunday October 19, 2025**

A visit to Arlington National Cemetery offers a profound and moving experience, honoring the sacrifices of those who served the United States. Known for its iconic white headstones and beautiful, solemn landscapes, the cemetery is a place of remembrance and reflection. Witness the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, pay respects at the graves of prominent leaders, and see the Eternal Flame at President John F. Kennedy's gravesite. The cemetery's memorials and monuments also tell stories of courage and dedication, providing visitors with an opportunity to learn about and appreciate American history and military service.

Next, visit the Pentagon Memorial, honoring the 184 lives lost in the September 11 attack on the Pentagon. Located just outside the Pentagon building, this solemn memorial features 184 illuminated benches arranged by the birth year of each victim, symbolizing their unique lives. Each bench is engraved with a name and positioned to reflect whether the individual was in the Pentagon or aboard Flight 77. The serene, open space offers a place for reflection, remembrance, and peace. Lunch will be on your own at the food court here.

After a busy couple of days exploring Washington, D.C., we will head north to Jersey City for the final leg of our journey. Arriving in the late afternoon, we'll settle into our hotel before spending the evening taking in the breathtaking views of the New York City skyline, just across the Hudson River. Whether it's gazing at the shimmering lights of the Empire State Building or watching the city's iconic skyline glow as the sun sets, this will be a perfect way to unwind and reflect on our travels. A delicious group dinner is included tonight, providing an opportunity to relax and enjoy good company as we look forward to our next adventure. (Meals: B,D)

### **Monday October 20, 2025**

Today, we will embark on an exciting boat tour that will take us across New York Harbor to two of the most iconic landmarks in American history. Our first stop will be Liberty Island, where we'll have the chance to visit the Statue of Liberty and explore the Statue of Liberty Museum. As we approach the island, you'll be greeted by the sight of Lady Liberty herself, a symbol of freedom and hope. The museum provides fascinating exhibits that highlight the statue's creation, history, and symbolic meaning. You'll also have time to take in stunning views of Manhattan from the island.

Afterward, the boat will continue to Ellis Island, where we'll explore the Ellis Island National Museum of Immigration.
